(Answer: the Post Office at Littleham Cross)




8. What does the rest of this sign say?

18. What colour is the boat - planted with a Littleham in Bloom floral display - which sits on the grass verge on the corner of Capel Lane? (Answer: blue)




19. Where is the only other post box on Littleham Road (other than at the Post Office at Littleham Cross)? (Answer: the corner of Elm Lane)




20. Where can you find Littleham Little Library? (Answer: outside no 88)
